Boarding School Regulations School year: 2023 – 2024

Boarding school is a facility offered to students and their families. Boarders must respect the boarding school's rules and regulations, which have been established in order to enable students to pursue his or her dance training and education in the best possible conditions. The boarding school is open from Sunday evening to Friday at noon and two weekends per month. A supervisor is on duty from 3:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. every day of the week.

"In order to facilitate logistics for long distance families, the boarding school remains open every other weekend. A catering service will not be available, but the boarding school will be supervised every weekend."

1/ What to pack (marked with the student's name)

2/ Rules :

1. Boarding school is an environment where everyone must dress correctly and use appropriate language.
2. Boarders can use their laptop and tablet (wifi access) until 9pm.
3. Boarders must remain within the school.
4. In order for a student to exit the school, families must send their requests to the boarding school director, who is the decision-maker.
5. Boarders must respect the following schedules:

07h00	Wake up
07h00 - 07h30	Breakfast
18h30 - 20h15	Dinner or study or dance
21h00 - 07h00	Night

6. Study time is when students must do their personal work. They must respect the silence and those who are working. Study time is supervised.
7. The dormitory or bedrooms are resting areas and each student is responsible for the cleanliness and tidiness of the room and the furniture at his/her disposal. A deposit check (not cashed) of 300 euros will be requested to cover any necessary repairs in the case of damage!
8. No medication can be dispensed by the school. If necessary, please provide any necessary medication with an explanatory letter from the family for the boarding school director. (Parents can leave the medication with the boarding school director).
9. The school cannot be held responsible for the loss or theft of objects belonging to students or staff.

DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES IN THE ROOMS OR DORMITORIES.

3/ Sanctions
